“District level workshop for CHOs and NTEP key staffs for effective TB diagnosis, treatment, surveillance, and prevention in Ballari District”

Date: 24th January, 2024

Background:

- To delve into specialized areas such as Differentiated TB Care, surveillance, reporting, HIV/AIDS co-infection management, and orientation on Nikshay.

CHOs engaged in a group activity focusing on identifying gaps, challenges, and best practices at the Health and Wellness Center level, followed by presentations.

9. Orientation on Nikshay:

NTEP District Staff provided an orientation on Nikshay, the online portal for TB case management, enhancing participants' proficiency in digital tools for TB surveillance and reporting.

The workshop provided a platform for knowledge exchange and capacity building among CHOs and NTEP key staff in Ballari. Through interactive sessions and practical exercises, attendees gained insights into TB management strategies, community engagement initiatives, and the utilization of digital tools for surveillance and reporting.
